Next-Generation Residency

OVERVIEW

Being a resident means you are taking part in a very instrumental time at Calvary, and that you will help us execute the vision of our church. We won't let you just be a consumer, but rather an investor in something that is bigger than yourself. Our prayer is that you will grow in your relationship with Jesus, build meaningful and lasting relationships, and gain a new perspective on ministry. You will receive a diverse training by supporting the various ministries at Calvary Baptist Church, but your main focus will be to build meaningful relationships, and to implement the church's strategies over the course of 2021. Your primary ministry outlet will be CSM (Calvary's Student Ministry), where you and the other resident will be given the responsibility of making it your own under the leadership of the Next-Generation Pastor and Team.

OUR COMMITMENTS TO YOU

- We will pray for you.
- We will invest in you. You won't just be a coffee-runner.
- We will be available for any needed advice or help, both in life and ministry.
- We will provide you with a mentor that will pour into you on a weekly basis.
- We will have a detailed weekly schedule for you, so you know what you'll be doing.
- We will provide you with your own workspace.
- We will accommodate your schedule so you'll be able to have a part-time job if needed.
- We will have a place for you to live, free of charge.

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU

- That you will be part of one of Calvary's D-Groups.
- That you will be an active member of Calvary, not just a consumer.
- That you choose a member of Calvary to pour into on a weekly basis.
- That you be an active part of Calvary's Young Adult ministry. You won't be in charge, but you will take part in all that it does.
- That you will participate in various Ministry Projects and Mission Trips.

For example:

- Vacation Bible School
- Local Mission Projects
 - Dorcas House
 - Pregnancy Resource Center
 - Etc.
- *Together for Hope* Mission Trip
- *Mission of Hope* Mission Trips
- That you will live with a missionary mindset.
- That you commit for one year, starting in January of 2021 and ending before Christmas of December 2021.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- You will be directly under the leadership of the Next-Generation Pastor to implement strategies for discipling students, and growing the student ministry. This will include developing meaningful relationships with students primarily of your own gender. Female residents will be focused on Girl's Discipleship, and vice versa for males. This is your main ministry responsibility.
- You will also support and serve other ministries in the church, according to your gifting. Some examples would be to help in the Children's Ministry, Young Adults, Worship, or Creative.
- You will be considered as part of Calvary's Ministry Staff, not just an intern. This means that you will also be responsible for any other duties that are assigned to you.

OUR EXPECTATIONS OF YOU

- That you are a growing disciple of Jesus Christ, and acknowledge Him as LORD over your life, desiring to know Him as you make Him known.
- That you are in agreement with Calvary's *Statement of Beliefs*, values, and vision (<https://www.cbclr.org/about/what-we-believe/>).
- That you make this ministry your own, be gifted in building relationships, and be someone who will do what is necessary to accomplish the mission.
- That you be a self-starter and confident in your abilities, gifting and calling.
- That you show up every day having already been fed in your walk with Christ, and not rely on us to spiritually hold your hand.
- That you be a team player, and prioritize the mission over *personal preference*.

- That you are able to follow leadership vision and direction easily.
- That you be on time, if not early, and be prepared.
- That you strive to be above reproach both in conduct and lifestyle as you grow to be more like Christ.
- That you desire to work in full-time ministry.

THE BENEFITS YOU'LL HAVE

- A place to live **free of charge**, with no utility bills either. This will be either in our Mission House, or with a host family.
- A stipend of \$500 a month, with the ability to have another part time job if desired.
- Real world ministry experience and training, not just with the viewpoint of serving, but leading a ministry as well.
- A Church that promises to love and care for you while you're here.
- Biblical teaching that will strengthen your relationship with Christ.

OTHER INFO YOU SHOULD (PROBABLY) KNOW THAT WOULDN'T FIT INTO OUR NICELY ORGANIZED CATEGORIES

- Your move-in is December 28th-30th, with your first official day being January 4th. This is non-negotiable.
- There is a Worship Night on December 31st, going into January 1st that we ask you to be present for (pending COVID-19).
- Starting January 1st, we will begin 31 Days of Prayer for the future of Calvary. We ask that you be an active participant in this for the month of January.
